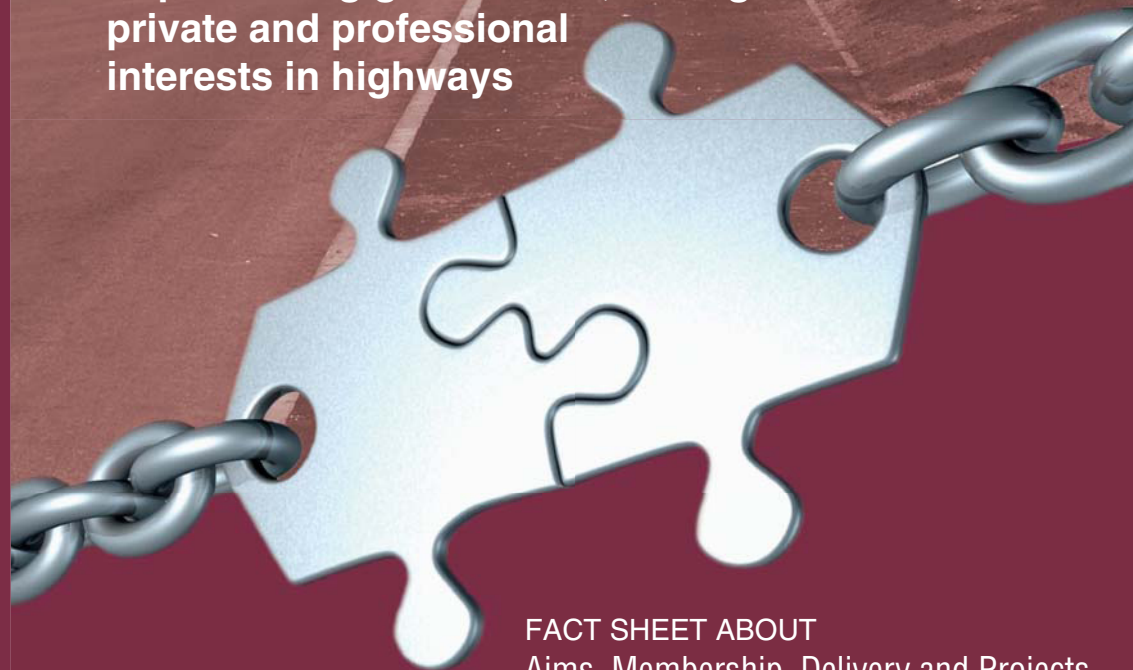

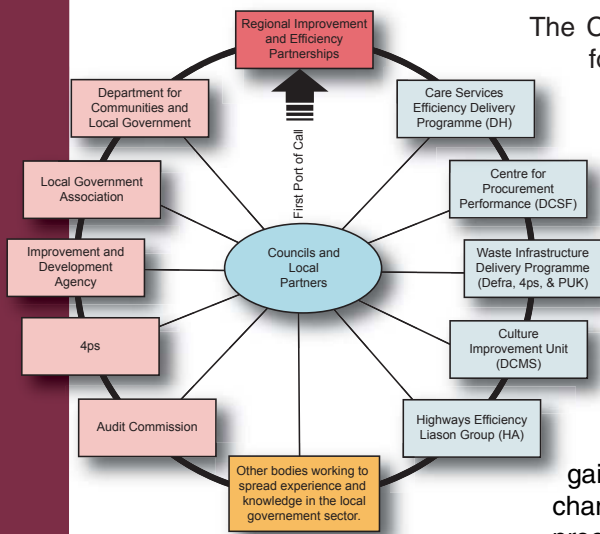

HELG Aim

To support the whole highways industry in identifying and delivering improved and increasingly efficient highways services.

HELG Context

In an increasingly tough financial environment, highways expenditure is under pressure. The highways industry as a whole, ie public and private sectors, need to do everything possible to continue to deliver and to improve services to the public in innovative and more efficient ways. With national value for money targets in place, but no individual local authority or service targets, the responsibility to deliver improvement to services and to achieve value for money gains lies with councils.



The CLG publication 'Delivering Value for Money in Local Government: Meeting the challenge of CSR07' identifies key organisations and the support structure for Councils. HELG is the only one related to highways:

Construction is a major part of expenditure and highways is a significant area within construction.
